

Jackson Aviation Scholarship Application Instructions - 2016

Greene County youth under the age of 22 interested in careers in aviation are invited to apply for any of the following Jackson Aviation Scholarships:

(a) Introduction to Flight - \$200 for introductory ground school and about an hour of flight instruction.

(b) Private Pilot's License - \$1,500 financial assistance for students working toward a Private Pilot's License.

(c) Advanced Rating - \$1,500 financial assistance for a licensed pilot working toward an advanced rating.

All scholarship-financed ground school and flight instruction is to be conducted through Greene County - Lewis A. Jackson Regional Airport businesses which have been vetted by the Greene County Airport Authority. Applicants must be residents of Greene County or full-time students in Greene County schools. Scholarship funds must be used within 18 months of date of award.

To apply for the Introductory Flight scholarship, the applicant must:

(a) Write an essay discussing his/her interest in an aviation career. The essay must be typed double-spaced and be a minimum of one page in length. Proper grammar and spelling are important.

(b) Submit one or more letters of recommendation from teachers, Scout leaders, CAP leaders, etc.

(c) Submit a resume that includes age, academic qualifications (including courses taken and grades achieved), extra-curricular activities, name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address, if applicable

(d) Return signed Participation Form (on back of these instructions.)

(e) Be at least 13 years old.

To apply for the Private Pilot's License scholarship, the applicant must:

(a) Write an essay discussing his/her interest in an aviation career. The essay must be typed double-spaced and be a minimum of one page in length. Proper grammar and spelling are important.

(b) Submit one or more letters of recommendation from teachers, Scout leaders, CAP leaders, etc.

(c) List any previous ground school and flight instruction and submit a letter of recommendation from the student's previous flight instructor(s), if applicable.

(d) Return signed Participation Form (on back of these instructions.)

(e) Be able to pass a Third Class flight physical.

(f) Be at least 15 years old.

(g) Submit a resume that includes age, academic qualifications (including courses taken and grades achieved), extra-curricular activities, name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address, if applicable.

Applicants that have started or completed ground school will be given priority.

To apply for the Advanced Rating Scholarship, the applicant must:

- (a) Write an essay and submit letters of recommendation, same as for the Private Pilot's License scholarship, above.
- (b) Hold a Private Pilot's License.
- (c) Hold a valid flight physical for the rating being sought.
- (d) Return signed Participation Form (below.)
- (e) Submit a resume that includes name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, academic qualifications (including courses taken and grades achieved), extra-curricular activities, and previous ground school and flight training.
